Dear David Burger:

This letter responds to your Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request received by the U.S. Department of State, Information Access Programs Directorate on December 8, 2025. A copy of your request is attached for your reference. This Office assigned your request the subject reference number for tracking.

Upon review of your request, which is regarding a we have determined that records responsive to your previously fulfilled request, **F-2025-28917** (“the former”), which was processed by the Office of Consular Affairs, Office of Overseas Citizens' Services (“OCS/OOCS”); and in concurrence with OCS/OOCS, we have determined that your request is duplicative of the former request.

OCS/OOCS processed the former request and after a performing a thorough and complete search produced all records which were responsive to your request. On December 3, 2025, you were emailed a final response letter with 20 pages of records released in part pursuant to FOIA exemption 6; 5 U.S.C. § 552(b)(6), which concerns material that, if released, would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of an individual’s personal privacy. For your reference and convenience, that package enclosed.

As such, this request, F-2026-05989, will be administratively closed.
