This is a request under the Freedom of Information Act. I request the complete American Citizen Services (ACS) case file maintained by U.S. Embassy Lomé concerning U.S. citizen and veteran Sergeant Kelvin Blas, whose U.S. passport was seized in Togo. Records sought include, but are not limited to: - ACS case notes and internal memoranda. - Emails between ACS staff and Embassy leadership referencing Sgt. Blas. - Cables to/from Department of State headquarters regarding his case. - All scanned forms and documents tied to the case, including DS-1504 and any ACS detention, welfare, or repatriation forms. - Arrest, detention, or passport seizure tracking logs. - TECS, PIERS, or related database entries associated with his case. - Any correspondence with Togolese authorities attached to the ACS file. Timeframe: From the date of Sgt. Blas's passport seizure to the present. Please conduct a comprehensive search of ACS section records, consular staff email accounts, and Embassy leadership correspondence relevant to this case.
