This is a request under the Freedom of Information Act. I request copies of all escalation tracking logs, tracking spreadsheets, or case management records maintained by the Bureau of Consular Affairs (Consular Affairs HQ in Washington, D.C.) concerning U.S. citizen and veteran Sergeant Kelvin Blas. Records sought include: - Case escalation or tracking logs used by CA/OCS to monitor consular cases involving stranded Americans. - Entries, notes, or status updates relating specifically to Sgt. Blas's case. - Any internal escalation dashboards, reports, or data summaries showing how his case was categorized or escalated. - Communications or attachments explaining updates or closure of his case status in such tracking systems. Timeframe: From the date of Sgt. Blas's passport seizure to the present. Please search CA/OCS case management systems, internal escalation logs, and related record-keeping tools.

I request expedited processing pursuant to 5 U.S.C. § 552(a)(6)(E). This matter involves an individual's life and safety, as well as the urgent need to inform the public of actual or alleged federal government activity. Sgt. Kelvin Blas has been stranded abroad for more than five years, his U.S. passport was seized, and he continues to face imminent harm from lack of repatriation assistance. Delay in disclosure could reasonably be expected to threaten the life or physical safety of a U.S. citizen, and the public has an urgent interest in government accountability on this matter.
