Thank you for the update. I appreciate the confirmation that DTA continues to process the November 18, 2025 request.

I did want to note, for context, that the records sought are recent (2025), centrally relevant to ongoing federal–state communications, and the type that would ordinarily be maintained and retrievable through standard electronic systems (email archives, shared drives, or case files), rather than legacy or archival storage.

Given the defined date range, specific subject matter, and the fact that many of the referenced communications involve formal correspondence with federal agencies and contractors, I would expect the universe of potentially responsive records to be reasonably identifiable at this stage.

I am not requesting acceleration beyond what the statute allows at this time. I simply wanted to flag that the scope and recency of the request suggest these records should be readily searchable, and I appreciate your continued attention to moving the review forward efficiently.

Please let me know if there are any specific issues affecting retrieval or review that I should be aware of.
